- **(12/22) Rock Island Township Emergency Food and Shelter Funding** – In February or March, the Township usually (but not always) receives a grant allowing us to help families by paying one month’s rent. The funding is intended to prevent homelessness and applicants who are normally ineligible for other types of assistance may qualify for this program. The maximum grant is \$450.
